You will experience pushes, pulls, twists, and gravity. **Draw a table** neatly in your homework book, or use a computer, to show when you experience these.

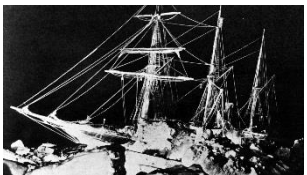
Push	Pull	Twist	Gravity
