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<i>The prefixes dis and mis both have negative meanings.</i>	<i>The prefix il – can give the opposite meaning to a word when added.</i>	<i>ation – is added to a verb to form a noun (remember previously taught rules) silent e is dropped before adding ation When a word ends in a 'y', change to 'i' before the suffix –ation is added</i>	<i>Morphology - Provides opportunity to find links from previously taught spelling/structure of words and parts of words (Stems-roots-prefixes- suffixes etc.)</i>	<i>If the last syllable of a word is stressed and ends with one consonant letter which has just one vowel letter before it, the final consonant letter is doubled before any ending beginning with a vowel is added. The consonant letter is not doubled if the syllable is unstressed.</i>
