Dear parents and carers,

Next week we have two focus books. We will read What If We Were All the Same? by C.M Harris, a book celebrating differences in all living things. We will also read What Do Grown-Ups Do All Day? by Virginie Morgand, which explores a diverse range of workplaces and what grown-ups might do there. The book depicts punk rock drummers, journalists, nurses, chefs, designers and more! Anything is possible for girls and boys! The children will have the opportunity to write about what they want to be when they grow up in their writing book this week. Here is a rough outline of the activities that we will be covering next week but please note they may be completed on different days in each class.

Phase 2 phonics

We teach the children to read and write through the Letters and Sounds phonics programme. We have just come to the end of teaching Phase 2 phonics. Next week we will assess how they have got on so far with recognising the



letter sounds, blending sounds into words (for reading) and segmenting words into sounds (for spelling).

The phonemes/ graphemes in Phase 2 are:

Set 1	Set 2	Set 3	Set 4	Set 5
satp	inmd	gock	ck e u r	h b f, ff l, ll ss

In Phase 2, the children have also been exposed to 'tricky words'; words that cannot be sounded out. These are: **the**, **no**, **go**, **into**, **to**, **I**
