

School Kitchen Corner

Chicken curry

The chicken and veggie curry are extremely popular at Southville school. This week we served nearly 200 portions.

Have a go at making it at home. You can also use butternut squash or Quorn as an alternative to meat.

Serves – 5 portions

Ingredients

560g Diced Chicken
1g Chilli Powder
2g Ground Turmeric
2g Ground Coriander
2g Ground Cumin
2g Paprika
2g Ground Ginger
15ml vegetable oil
15g Garlic Puree
200g Diced Onion
125g Diced Mixed Peppers
250g Chopped Tomatoes
6g vegetables stock powder
10ml Lemon Juice
350ml Water
70g Tomato Puree
150g plain long-life yogurt
Seasoning (to taste)



Method

1. Marinade the chicken overnight in the spices.
2. Lightly sauté the chicken in a little oil
3. Add the garlic and cook for a few minutes
4. Add the Diced onions and Peppers to the mix
5. Cook until the onions are tender
6. Add the chopped tomatoes, vegetable stock, lemon juice, water, and tomato puree - stir well
7. Simmer for approx. 30 minutes, until the chicken is cooked through.
8. Add the natural yogurt, stir well and season to taste and serve.


