## **Treasurer's Report**

Since the last meeting we have raised:

- £6,410.04 from the Winter Fair
- £102.23 at the Year 3/4 carols

- We covered the cost of providing crackers and table cloths for the school Christmas lunches by selling crackers and actually made £20.70 profit (cost was £384.40 for 1000 crackers and wrapping paper and we took £405.10 selling the excess crackers)

- £25.82 bank interest

Between the bank account, savings account and cash we have approx. £28,000. However, of that we have approx £3,500 ring fenced as detailed in previous meetings, plus money for the lantern parade and for half the cost of the Christmas theater tickets. Realistically we have £20,000 that can be used for funding school projects/enrichment.
