Treasurer's Report	<p>Since the last meeting in March we have raised £1,582.32 from the Spring Disco's £7,253.87 from the May Fair (including an extra £500 via match funding from Lloyds.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - £59.72 in bank interest - £67.73 from Easy Fundraising - £15.02 from Amazon (this scheme has now ceased) - £9.03 from Invest my Community (formerly Donate My School) and Gift Aid on this donation will follow. <p>We have also spent some money!</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - £1500 towards the year 6 leavers hoodies and yearbooks - £1,956.19 reimbursement the school for the remainder of our ring fenced amounts for outdoor play equipment, art supplies from the Lorenzo Etherington donation and food equipment raised by the Box-E event pre covid - £2,923.20 for half of all the Theatre Tickets for the Christmas Shows - £300 for Duo Lingo books for the libraries - £300 for supplies for the school to take part in last Autumn's Art's trail - £140 on renewing our insurance! <p>Also, I would like to confirm that Scrapstore Membership will be renewed this month.</p> <p>Between the bank account, savings account and cash we have approx. £29,900 However, we have approx £18,000 ring fenced for things such as the new Merrywood playground equipment which leaves us approximately £11,900 for future enrichment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Food equipment for Merrywood, end of year treat and christmas shows still to purchase
