Uniform

Following my communication with you in the summer regarding our school uniform, there has been a noticeable improvement across the school in the consistency and general smartness of the children so thank you so much for your support with this.

One of the changes in this policy was that we are moving away from children wearing tshirts for PE in the colour of their school house, in favour of a white or red polo shirt or tshirt.
