### **1)Treasurers report from Stuart,**

Since the last meeting we have raised a total of £6,903 itemised below:

£425 from the wreath making workshop

£6,264 from the Winter Fair

£137 from Carols

£21 from Easy Fundraising

£56 in bank interest.

In this period, we also spent money on Christmas Crackers (£301). We agreed to give £500 to the school food bank in December, which is yet to be taken from the account.

Between the bank account, savings account and cash we have over £40,000. However, of that we have approximately £13,100 ring fenced for things previously agreed with school in previous meetings. This leaves us with approximately £28,000 for funding future school enrichment.
